


Fishing Maps

The Tin Shed Drift is approximately contained in the blue oval that is outlined on the map. The best Chinook fishing in this area can be either when the tide is going out or when the tide is coming in. I prefer to fish in this area when the tide is going out. Most of the time (not always) the fish will be suspended on the edge of Possession Bar in this area. The edge of the Bar in this area is very steep. When the tide is going out, the tide pushes the bait and the salmon up against this steep edge.

Gear that I would recommend: Gibbs Red Racer Flasher with a Goldstar 3.0 or 3.5 Kingfisher spoon 42 inches behind the flasher. Spoon colors that I recommend are #395 (Herring Aide) and 964 (Green Spatter/Red Stripe). During the summer Chinook season I would recommend using 5" Tomic Plugs in colors 602 and 603.

I like fishing this corner for Chinook when the tide is coming in.
